



# Respect Life

Henry Hyde (1924-2007) was a Republican congressman from Illinois and a staunch supporter of life. Upset with public funding for abortions, he pushed an amendment through Congress that prohibited the expenditure of Medicaid funds for elective abortions. Now known as the Hyde Amendment, it has been included with every national budget since 1980.

Serving the nation from 1975 until his death, Hyde was a vocal supporter of people in the pro-life movement. He made interesting comments about Judgment Day. He noted that "[you] will not be alone. There will be a chorus of voices that have never been heard in this world, ...they will say to God, 'spare him because he loved us.'"

Currently, President Biden has submitted a budget that does NOT include the Hyde Amendment. Your senators and congressmen must be made aware that you support the amendment, you are a Catholic, and you vote.




### Oberammergau




Everything we own belongs to God, but out of His goodness, He allows us to use what rightfully belongs to Him. We are just managers and stewards of what God has entrusted to us.
