



Receive me, dear and chosen Father, and the offering of every movement of my body and soul, which I desire to present through you to my blessed Lord.





A Promise is a Promise

It was 1633, and the village of Oberammergau welcomed their soldiers home after the Thirty Years' War. Sadly, the soldiers carried with them the deadly black plague to their beloved village in the Bavarian Alps. It spread quickly and soon 84 people from a population of only about 600 had died from it.

Fearing more suffering and death, the villagers of Oberammergau prayed fervently to God for help and protection while gathering in front of a large crucifix (which still hangs in the parish church). They prayed and they made a promise to God if He would spare them from the plague, they would re-enact the last week of Jesus' life every 10 years in thanksgiving.

From that day on, nobody else died of the plague in Oberammergau.

The next year in 1634, the first Oberammergau Passion Play was performed in a meadow in front of the church.

In many places around the world Passion Plays are performed. But only in Oberammergau does the play have its origin in a promise to God. The faithful villagers have performed it without a break from 1634 until today.

Few of us today would think we were bound by a promise we had made a few months ago. The people of Oberammergau take seriously what their ancestors vowed to God 366 years ago!

HURRICANE SEASON IS HERE. BASIC DISASTER SUPPLIES KIT

To assemble your kit, store items in airtight plastic bags and put your entire disaster supplies kit in one or two easy-to-carry containers such as plastic bins or a duffel bag. A basic emergency supply kit could include the following recommended items:

- Water (one gallon per person per day for several days, for drinking and sanitation)
- Food (at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food)
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert
- Flashlight

- First aid kit
- Extra batteries
- Whistle (to signal for help)
- Dust mask (to help filter contaminated air)
- Plastic sheeting and duct tape (to shelter in place)
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties (for personal sanitation)
- Wrench or pliers (to turn off utilities)
- Manual can opener (for food)
- Local maps
- Cell phone with chargers and a backup battery

Respect Life

David Daleiden is a reporter, an anti-abortion activist, and the founder of the Center for Medical Progress. Like many a reporter, he went undercover to infiltrate Planned Parenthood and expose their financial dealings. In 2015, he videotaped Planned Parenthood employees discussing pricing for the sale of human fetal tissue, especially organs.

Journalists who exposed the illegal Watergate dealings of President Nixon were hailed as heroes. In contrast, the State of California filed 15 felony charges against Daleiden, which are still active, and the federal government issued an injunction against showing his videos.

Daleiden faces civil fines, currently under appeal, for violating the privacy of individuals at Planned Parenthood. He has filed civil suits against former California prosecutors Xavier Becerra (current U.S. Attorney General) and U.S.

What changed the Cavens' attitude toward giving?




