



On November 30, an international organization, "Cities Against the Death Penalty," celebrates

"Cities For Life." It's a good time to remember death row inmates in your prayers.

On a positive note, Florida announced the exoneration of Robert Duboise due to DNA evidence, which showed his innocence. He has been on death row for 37 years. Since Florida re-instituted the death penalty in 1973, 99 people have been executed while 30 have been exonerated. (Note: According to "Floridians For Alternatives To The Death Penalty," 172 people in the United States have been exonerated in that period. (See fadp.org.)

Pope Francis has made it clear that the death penalty is no longer acceptable. Modern penal practices have made it possible to protect prison guards and the public from those that commit the most heinous crimes. It is time for every Catholic to be on the correct side of this issue. Even better, help work towards the abolition of this practice in our State and our Country.






PRAYER FOR ALL VETERANS

RULES FOR ATTENDING MASS DURING THE PANDEMIC

- Everyone entering the Church must have on a mask. A scarf or bandana will also suffice.
- Everyone must sanitize their hands before entering the Church. Additionally, please sanitize your hands immediately ly before you receive Communion and immediately afterwards.
- You may only receive Communion passively on your hand, not on your tongue. Please do not attempt to take the Host from the priest and do not cup your hand like a basket. Keep your hand as flat as possible. The priest will then attempt to

- Please consider attending the 7:00 AM or 5:30 PM Masses on Sunday, as they are usually more lightly attended.
- **Social Distancing rules must be followed.** Pews have been roped off to create space. Please do not sit close to people you do not live with.
- The sign of Peace will be omitted.


We thank you for your support and ask for your prayers as we strive to meet our CFA assessment.



and then (if they feel called by God) to prepare for the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and/or Confirmation.

RCIA is for: Non-Catholics who are interested in exploring Catholicism, Catholic adults who missed out on First Communion and/or Confirmation, anyone who is spiritually searching, and those who might be quietly wishing to receive Christ in the Eucharist.




